Citizenship and Social Development Online Reading Award Scheme 2023/24

Summary

The purpose of this circular memorandum is to invite secondary schools to participate in the captioned student activity.

Background

2. The Education Bureau (EDB) launched Citizenship and Social Development (CS) at Secondary 4 in the 2021/22 school year, and is now extended to Secondary 6 this school year. CS is a senior secondary core subject which covers the themes of our country, Hong Kong and the contemporary world. The subject aims to help students build a solid



knowledge base with an emphasis on deepening their understanding of the latest developments and achievements of the country, and attaches importance to cultivating students' proper values, positive attitudes and sense of national identity. EDB has been actively promoting the development of CS through various key tasks, including curriculum planning, learning and teaching resources development, teacher training, and Mainland study tours for students, etc.

Details

- 3. The online reading award scheme is organised by the Curriculum Development Institute of EDB and co-organised by the Academy of Chinese Studies. It aims to encourage senior secondary students to **learn CS through reading**, so as to enrich their knowledge, broaden their horizons, enhance students' interest in learning the subject, create a reading culture on campus and enhance students' self-directed learning. Please refer to **Annex 1** and **Annex 2** for the poster and schedule of the activity.
- 4. This activity is targeted at all Secondary 4 to 5 students in Hong Kong. Interested students should register through their respective schools for participation. They have to read articles or watch videos related to different themes of CS, and log in the activity webpage to answer questions related to the reading materials **from 16 May (Thursday) to 24 May (Friday) 2024**. There is no

limit on the number of participants for each school. Apart from the champion, first runner-up, second runner-up and merit awards, there are also "Outstanding Performance Award in 18 Districts" and "Most Actively Participating School Award" for this activity.
