Citizenship and Social Development Online Reading Award Scheme and Collection of Thematic Reading Reports 2025/26

Summary

The purpose of this circular memorandum is to invite secondary schools to participate in the captioned student activity.

Background

2. Citizenship and Social Development (CS) was introduced at Secondary Four starting from the 2021/22 school year and is now fully implemented across senior secondary levels. The CS curriculum comprises three themes, namely “Hong Kong under ‘One Country, Two Systems’”, “Our Country since Reform and Opening-up” and “Interconnectedness and Interdependence of the Contemporary World”. These themes aim to help students build a solid knowledge base and develop skills of critical thinking, rational analysis and problem-solving, as well as foster proper values and attitudes and a sense of national identity, through studying important topics relating to Hong Kong, our country and the contemporary world. The Education Bureau (EDB) has been actively promoting the development of CS through various key tasks, including curriculum planning, learning and teaching resources development, teacher training, and Mainland study tours for students, etc.

Details

A. CS Online Reading Award Scheme

3. Building on the CS Online Reading Award Scheme organised in 2024, the EDB will organise the “Citizenship and Social Development Online Reading Award Scheme 2025/26” (the Award Scheme) in this school year, in collaboration with the Academy of Chinese Studies. The Scheme aims to encourage senior secondary students to learn CS through reading, broaden their knowledge and horizons, enhance their interest in the subject, foster a positive reading

culture on campus, and promote students' self-directed learning. Please refer to **Annex 1** and **Annex 2** for the poster and schedule of the activity.

4. This award scheme is targeted at all senior secondary students in Hong Kong. Students are required to register through their respective schools. They are required to read Chinese or English reading materials (including articles, videos, infographics, etc.) related to the themes of CS and log in to the activity platform to answer questions related to the reading materials during the period **from 26 January 2026 (Mon) to 4 February 2026 (Wed)**. There is no limit on the number of participants in each school. The awards for this activity include:

(1) **Individual Awards:** First Prize, Second Prize, and Merit Award;

(2) **Group Awards:** Outstanding Performance Award and Most Actively Participating School Award.

B. Collection of CS Thematic Reading Reports

7. Through this collection of CS thematic reading reports, students are encouraged to make good use of inspiration gained from reading and to flexibly apply information technology and multimedia skills in their creative works, with a view to deepening their understanding of the key learning foci of Citizenship and Social Development while enhancing their analytical, organisational, and creative skills, as well as their self-directed learning skills, media and information literacy, and collaboration skills through the hands-on practice.

8. To showcase students' learning outcomes, the outstanding entries will be uploaded onto the website of the Education Bureau and/or used for educational and publicity purposes. For details and application procedures, please refer to **Annex 4**. The submission deadline for entries is **15 April 2026 (Wed)**.

9. To facilitate schools in understanding the details of the Collection of Thematic Reading Reports activity, the EDB will organise an online briefing session on **6 February 2026 (Fri)**. Details will be announced on the activity website in due course.

Collection of Thematic Reading Reports

Objectives

- Students are encouraged to make good use of inspiration gained from reading and to flexibly apply information technology and multimedia skills in their creative works, with a view to deepening their understanding of the key learning foci of Citizenship and Social Development while enhancing their analytical, organisational, and creative skills, as well as their self-directed learning skills, media and information literacy, and collaboration skills through the hands-on practice.

Target Participants, Participation Format, Training Workshops and Final Judging Session for Outstanding Works

- The target participants are all senior secondary students (S4 to S6) in Hong Kong.
- Students interested in this activity must also register for the “CS Online Reading Award Scheme”.
- Students must form teams and register through their schools. Each school may nominate a maximum of 5 teams to participate, with each team consisting of 2 to 4 members. Each participating team is required to create one entry based on one of the designated themes and formats designated by the organiser, and submission must be made through the students’ enrolled school only.
- To enhance students’ mastery of multimedia production skills, 2 online training workshops will be offered. Students are welcome to register for these workshops. Details will be announced on the activity website in due course.
- An “Activity Kit” and a “Sample Project Introduction” will be provided for schools’ and students’ reference. Details will be announced on the activity website in due course.
- Shortlisted outstanding teams will be invited to attend the “Final judging session for outstanding works” for the final selection of award winners. Details will be announced on the activity website in due course.

Project Themes and Formats

- Participating teams must choose **one of the following themes and formats** for their creation:

Theme

1. Showcasing China’s Achievements in data
2. The connection between our country and the world

Format

1. Multimedia works, e.g., infographics, videos, AI digital avatars.
2. Interactive game works, e.g., online quiz games.

Entry Format and Requirements

- Project Introduction: Each participating team is required to submit a project introduction of no less than **250 words (in Chinese)** or **200 words (in English)**. The content must cover the following:
 - (1) The main idea of the work and its relevance to the key learning foci of CS.
 - (2) The creative concept and how reading materials inspired the creation.
 - (3) How the creative process deepened the understanding of the key learning foci of CS.
 - (4) Significant insights or reflections gained during the creative process.
- The electronic file name of each project introduction must include the school's Chinese name, theme (1/2), and group (A/B/C/D/E). For example:
“杏壇中學_主題 1_組別 A.pdf”/“杏壇中學_主題 1_組別 B.doc”.
- The activity accepts online submissions **ONLY**. Physical submissions will not be considered.
 - For submissions of infographics or video entries: Upload the file to a commonly used cloud storage service (e.g., Google Drive or OneDrive) and set the sharing permission to “private link”, then submit the sharing link via the official activity webpage: <https://csreadingscheme2025.chiculture.org.hk/enterthematic>
 - For submissions of web-based quiz game: The accessible game link should be placed separately in a document. Upload the file to a commonly used cloud storage service (e.g., Google Drive or OneDrive) together with the “**Project Introduction**” and any related attachments, with access set to “private link”, then submit the sharing link via the official activity webpage.

Duration	No longer than 3 minutes

Resolution	Minimum 1280x720 (720P)
Language	Cantonese, Putonghua, or English may be used

All materials must not infringe copyrights or any interests of any other parties and must not contain or reference the names, labels or trademarks of any individuals, schools, companies, or brands.

Submission requirements

- Guiding teachers must complete the submission **on or before 15 April 2026 (Wed)** via the official activity webpage:
<https://csreadingscheme2025.chiculture.org.hk/enterthematic> by following the instructions to upload the entry link, project introduction, and all required attachments (e.g. subtitle script for video entries or question-and-answer list for online quiz game entries)



Judging Criteria

- Relevance to the theme and depth of content (35%)
- Creative concept and inspiration gained from reading materials (25%)
- Creative design (20%)
- Artistic or visual presentation (15%)
- Project introduction (5%)

Online Training Workshops

- Two online training workshops will be offered: (1) Multimedia Skills Training Workshop and (2) Interactive Game Production Skills Training Workshop, tentatively scheduled to be held on **21 March 2026 (Sat)**. Schools interested in participating may register from **2 March 2026 (Mon) to 16 March 2026 (Mon)**.
- Details will be announced on the official activity website in due course. Successfully registered schools will be notified by email or SMS.

Final Judging Session for Outstanding Entries

- Teams with shortlisted outstanding entries will be invited to participate in the final judging session for outstanding entries. Participating teams are required to deliver an oral presentation introducing their work and respond to questions from the adjudication panel. The adjudication panel will determine awards based on their performance. The entire process will be recorded on video.
- The adjudication session is tentatively scheduled to be held between **20 May 2026 (Wed) and 28 May 2026 (Thu)**. Details will be announced on the activity website in due course. The organiser will also notify the shortlisted teams by email or SMS.
- Shortlisted teams must prepare a presentation of no more than 8 slides and complete their oral report within 10 minutes, covering creative concept, production process, and insights gained, etc.

Awards and Prizes

- Awards: Outstanding Award, Merit Award, Best Content Award, Best Visual Award, Best Technical Award, Best Presentation Award, Best Instructor Award (for teachers), and Certificate of Appreciation for Participation (for schools).
- Prizes: Certificates, trophies and prizes.

Announcement of Results and Award Ceremony

- The list of winners will be announced in **June 2026** under the “Student Page” of the EDB’s “Citizenship and Social Development Web-based Resource Platform”. Winning schools and students will be notified by letters.
