

Board Game on Information Literacy

Purpose

This is to inform heads and teachers of secondary schools about the captioned learning and teaching resources.

Details

2. The Education Bureau (EDB) attaches importance to the nurturing of students' information literacy (IL) with a view to developing students' ability and attitudes to use information and communication technology effectively and ethically in learning and daily life. The EDB launched the updated "Information Literacy for Hong Kong Students" Learning Framework in 2024 with enhanced contents on Information Evaluation, Cyberbullying Prevention, Personal Data Privacy Protection and Internet Addiction Prevention. Moreover, a new literacy area titled "Recognise the ethical issues arising from the application of emerging and advanced information technologies" has been added.

3. Topics related to IL are embedded in various subjects, including Citizenship and Social Development (CS) at the senior secondary level. In order to enhance secondary school students' learning interest and motivation in developing their IL and deepen their learning, the EDB developed an IL board game (Board Game) (Chinese version) in the 2024/25 school year. The game enables students to gain a deeper understanding of the relationship between IL and proper values, as well as apply the related knowledge and skills in their daily life, in an interactive manner, so that they will become law-abiding, responsible citizens and lifelong learners. In view of the enthusiastic response from schools, the EDB has reprinted the Chinese version of the Board Game and newly produced the English version. The content of both the Chinese and English versions is identical, and both include a user guide which serves as a reference for teachers in conducting debriefing and guiding students' reflection.



4. The quantity of Board Game is limited, **each secondary school** can request for **5 sets** of Board Game on a **first-come, first-served** basis. Due to high school demand in the 2024/25 school year, a small amount of the Board Game (Chinese version) will be prioritised for allocation to the schools that had applied but did not receive it last year. Interested schools (priority will be given to those which have not applied for the Board Game) may download [the fillable PDF reply slip](#) (shown in Appendix 4a) from the CS Section webpage of the EDB and send the completed reply slip to cdocsd6@edb.gov.hk **on or before 5 February 2026 (Thursday)**. The EDB will notify schools in writing and the Board Game sets will be available for collection in due course at their respective Regional Education Offices during office hours from Monday to Friday.



5. The CS Section of the EDB tentatively plans to organise a professional development programme for teachers on "Promoting Information Literacy Education through Board Games" in April 2026. Secondary school teachers will be invited to share their learning and teaching experience as well as insights on using the Board Game in the classroom. Details will be

uploaded to the Training Calendar System of the EDB tentatively in March 2026 for teachers' enrolment. All teachers are welcome to join the programme.
